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About us

Novelty Fiction is an independent publisher of books, e-books, magazines, audiobooks and more. We are open for submissions all year round, and typically get back to the author with a decision within 4 weeks. Publication offers are issued via email, followed by acceptance via a simple online form.

Our primary goal is to create original, high-quality literary works that readers and reviewers may appreciate. Being a print-on-demand publisher, we guarantee neither sales nor revenue. However, our royalty rates are fair, and free support is available to authors as detailed below.

Depending on the platform, authors may receive a honorarium, a fixed royalty per copy sold or given away, or royalties as a percentage of revenue on sales. Royalties are paid annually. Small advances or free author copies may be provided solely at the publisher's discretion.

Our imprints

- NOVELTY FICTION – Reviews works of fiction. Offers free, limited help with revisions. Pays royalties set as a fixed amount per copy.
- NOVELTY FICTION GAZETTE – Reviews short stories only. Offers free, limited help with revisions. Pays a honorarium upon acceptance.
- DANICUM PUBLICUS – Reviews fiction, nonfiction, poetry etc. Offers free, extensive help with revisions, including creative input. Pays royalties set as 30 or 40 percent of revenue.
